


We need you and your ideas! Let's all make a resolution to work together to make 2026 the best year ever.

It has been made aware to me that the Aerie Membership procedures are unknown to most.

It is the 1st and 2nd proposers' responsibility to lead their candidate through. The application is the 1st step. After filling the application form, and paying the fee, it goes to the secretary or treasurer to be logged into the books.

After being logged in the next step is to be interviewed. Interviews are held the Monday night before each Tuesday Aerie meeting. Proposers or candidates are responsible for asking the membership committee which day they wish for an interview.

It is not this said committee or its members job to contact new candidates in any way, unless other arrangements have been made and agreed upon.

After the interview the next step is the introduction and voting for the candidate at a regular Tuesday meeting. The 1st or 2nd proposers must attend and introduce their candidates.

If voting is favorable the next step is to attend the 1st Aerie meeting of the month and be initiated into the membership. 1st and/or 2nd proposers must attend their candidate's initiation.

That is the way it works. Any other procedures are not approved and not in effect. Please just don't sign an application and forget about it! As proposers you are the connection between candidates and the Aerie. Give them the support and consideration they deserve. Remember candidates don't know how things work, proposers should!!


