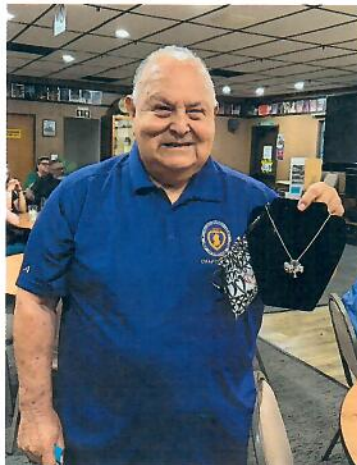

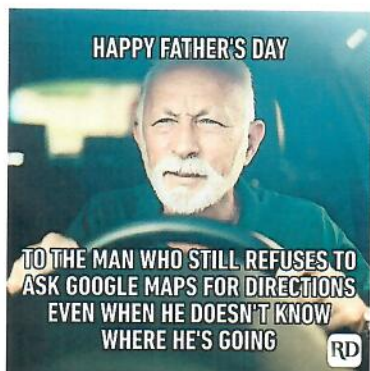
## From your Madam Vice President

The grace period is only there to allow them to pay-up before getting dropped completely and then they would have to go through the re-enrollment process. The grace period does NOT include membership privileges."***

Also, if you have changed any of your personal information (address, phone #, email, etc...) please send to me right away so I can update the information.
