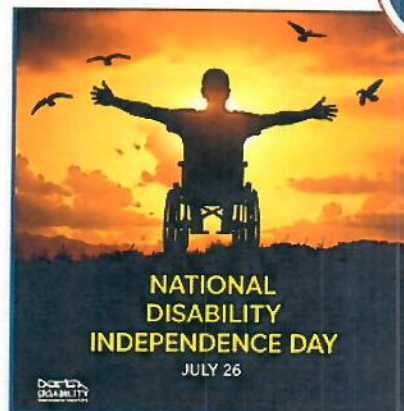

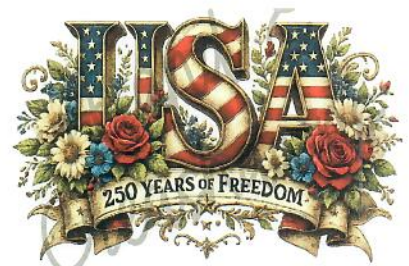
Also, congratulations to our Awesome Azusa Auxiliary who got the Traveling Banner at our meeting last month at Hemet Eagles #4055.

As we close out the finances from the last Eagles program year which ran from June 1, 2025 thru May 31, 2026, our Treasurer, Tom Roblee, has good news to report. Despite four major required expenses this spring, the Aerie is about \$22,000 in the black. The four major expenses were fire code required tree trimming, the replacement of our 20-year-old ice maker that finally decided to stop making ice, a repair on the walk-in bar cooler to keep our drinks cold, and a new kegerator to increase our draft beer selections. Thanks to the hard work from our Trustees who continue supporting events raising funds to keep the Aerie solvent and support our ongoing charity work.

Want to help make a difference? Talk to any of our Trustees or officers! A small contribution of your time and effort will make a big difference when multiplied by the combined efforts of our 230 brothers.

Reminder to members that Grand will drop your membership on July 11 if your dues are not paid. We still have 22 unpaid brothers. The list of unpaid brothers is posted in the bar. If you know someone who hasn't paid, reach out to them! Unpaid members can pay by visiting the Aerie with cash, check, or credit card if you are an Aerie member. As of now, if you have not paid your dues you are considered "**past due**" and "**delinquent**". The deadline to pay your dues for 2026-2027 was May 31, 2026. **This year, you will be dropped on July 11th if your dues have not been paid by July 10th 2026.**



Per FOE Grand Office: ***"If dues are not paid by May 31st, that member is not in good standing and thus does not benefit from membership privileges. They cannot attend meetings, vote, etc.. The grace period is only there to allow them to pay-up before getting dropped completely and then they would have to go through the re-enrollment process. The grace period does NOT include membership privileges."***

You can mail your renewal (Cash or Check) to me or leave behind the bar. Cards are **mailed** unless stated to leave behind the bar. Also, if you have changed any of your personal information (address, phone #, email, etc...) please send to me right away so I can update the information. For dues, please include \$30 per year and either drop your payment by the club or mail it to:
