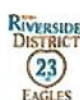

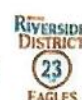

A few reminders and announcements:

- **Volunteers Needed:** Please continue to support our Eagles' functions by signing up for various volunteer roles. Every volunteer makes a difference, and your time and support help make our events successful.
- **Receivership Update:** We are pleased to announce that F.O.E. 2810 was officially released from receivership effective August 25, 2026. We sincerely thank everyone who supported the Aerie throughout the receivership process. The commitment and cooperation of our officers and members helped us reach this important milestone. Moving forward, we ask everyone to continue working together to strengthen our Aerie and build upon the progress we have made.
- **Marketing Committee Volunteers:** We are still seeking members interested in serving on a Marketing Committee. The committee will help promote Aerie events, activities, membership, and community involvement. If you have experience or simply an interest in marketing, social media, communications, or event promotion, we encourage you to get involved. Please get in touch with the Trustees if you are interested.
- **Rental Agreement Changes:** Changes to our rental agreements are currently in the works. We are consolidating our rental activities into one comprehensive rental form that clearly identifies the policies, rules, responsibilities, and requirements for each rental space. Our goal is to create a more consistent, transparent rental process for members, guests, and facility managers.
- **Kitchen Policy – Effective Immediately:** Access to the kitchen is limited to authorized individuals only. For everyone's safety, open-toed shoes and sandals are prohibited. Cooks and kitchen helpers, including those assisting with cleaning, must wear hairnets. Facial hair nets are also required when applicable. These requirements apply to anyone authorized to work in the kitchen. For any kitchen rental, please contact Paul at (323) 240-3483 about kitchen access and requirements.
- We also remind everyone that FOE 2810 maintains a zero-tolerance policy regarding theft, harassment, violence, or other inappropriate conduct. Together, we can continue to provide a profitable, enjoyable, and safe environment for all members and guests.

Azusa Aerie members, welcome to September! We have multiple announcements for the good of the order.

Membership: The Aerie currently has 216 members plus three dual members. Our growth goal for the year is 230 members. If you know someone who would benefit from Aerie fellowship, please invite them in. Be certain they sign the book three times and introduce them to some other members, so we get to know each other. Once they discover our friendly members, help them complete the application, pay the initiation fee and then attend the interview, Aerie meeting introduction, and finally, initiation into membership so they can begin enjoying the benefits we have!

Membership Milestone Pins: At the Grand convention, I had the opportunity to purchase our membership milestone pins. These are awarded to members at 5-year intervals beginning at 5 years and going up to 60 years! 37 members are eligible for the pins. Our milestone 30+ year members this year are:

Membership Cards: Grand will be shipping the new hard cards starting this week. Remember, Grand is printing 600,000 cards, so it may take time for your card to arrive. Look for them in the mail. These cards replace your yellow paper cards and provide you with the same rights and privileges. Yellow cards will still be used for new members until they receive their hard card from Grand.

Finances: QuickBooks and Compliance training at the Grand Convention was excellent. In January 2026, we finally implemented Grand's longstanding recommendation to adopt QuickBooks Online Edition (first recommended by Grand in 2020). Now, the Aerie is fully compliant and operates according to Grand recommended financial practices. Treasurer's and Auditor's reports are being sent to Grand to complete our reporting for the last fiscal year. The best news is, thanks to you and your attendance at dinners, events, as well as participation in raffles and drawings, the Aerie is in the black for the first half of the year. Many thanks to our bookkeeper Jeannie Gianessi for her work organizing the Aerie files and her ongoing reconciliation of payables. Next steps are to follow optional recommendations from Grand to automate additional regular payments and more diligently categorize our expenses so we can further refine our cost savings and ensure due diligence with our members' money.

Receivership: At the last Aerie meeting, our Grand Receiver reviewed the work of the Officers and Trustees since January. He was able to confirm 100% compliance to all Grand requirements and then congratulated all those involved and announced he was putting in the paperwork to Grand to end Receivership and return the Aerie to normal operations.

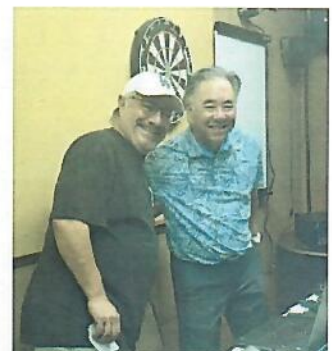

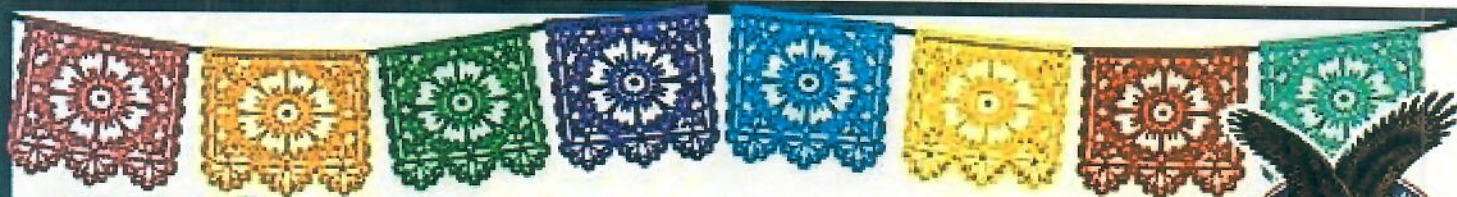

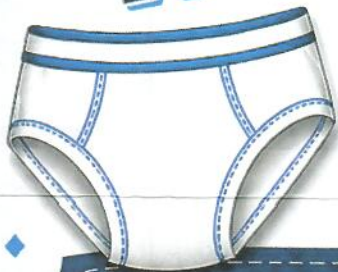
